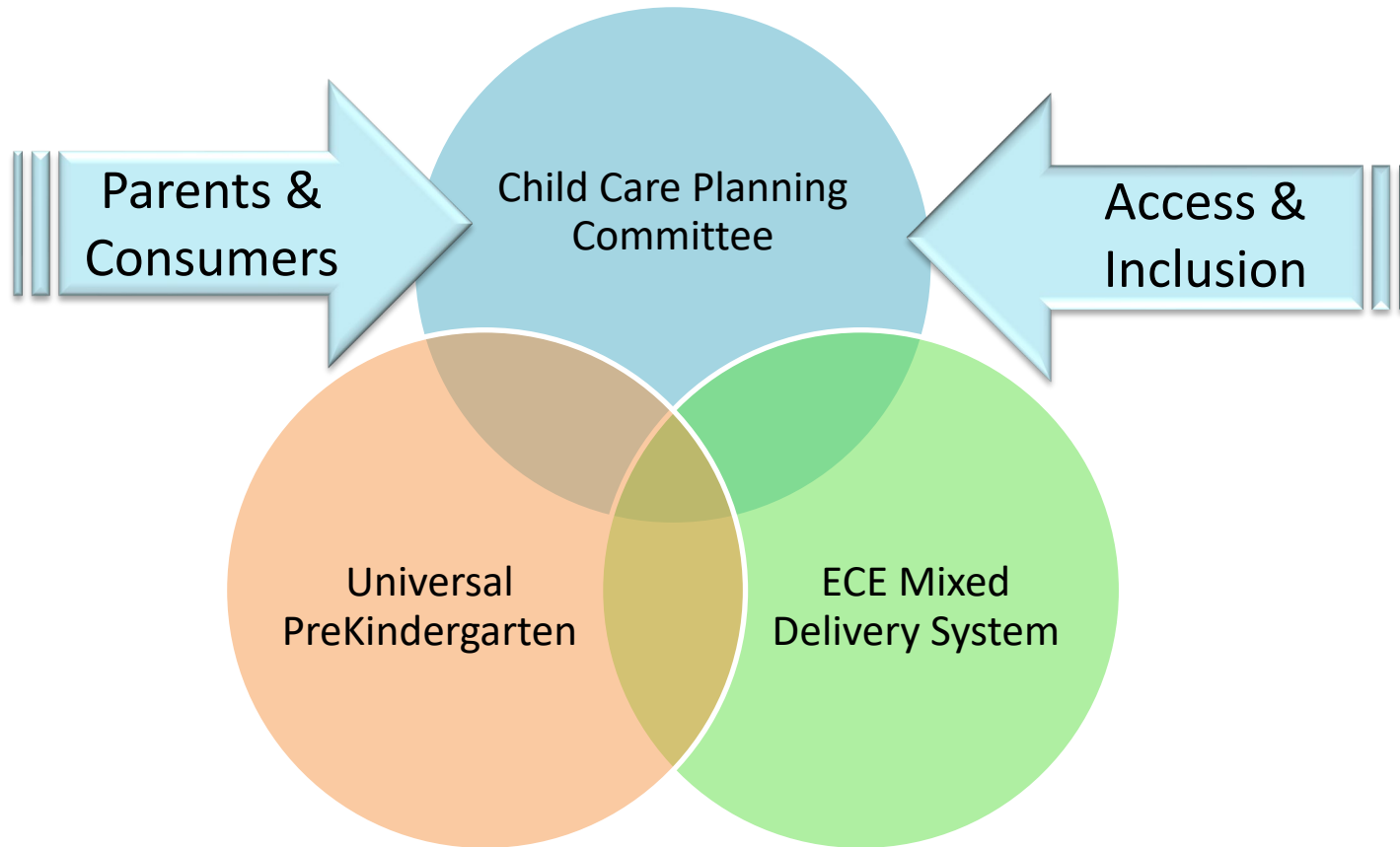


## What is the Role of Child Care Planning Committee in UPK?



- **Coordinate** with the LA County Office of Education (LACOE).
- Form a **single local Work Group – LPC CCPC**.
- **Plan** for, but not directly fund, UPK options in a mixed delivery system.
- Plan for increasing inclusion of **children with exceptional needs** in UPK.
- Plan for **workforce development**.
- Provide **outreach services and enrollment support** to meet needs of families.
- Plan for, **align and coordinate the plans**, with LEA that received funding under **California PreKindergarten Planning and Implementation Grant Program**.
- **Partner with tribes** as sovereign nations.
- **Develop a plan before June 30, 2023**.

Facilitate and coordinate discussions of the local Work Group.

## **Quality Start LA/ Workforce Pathways**

Partner with the local Quality Counts California to support the workforce.

## **Special Education**

Coordinate with special education local and regional partners

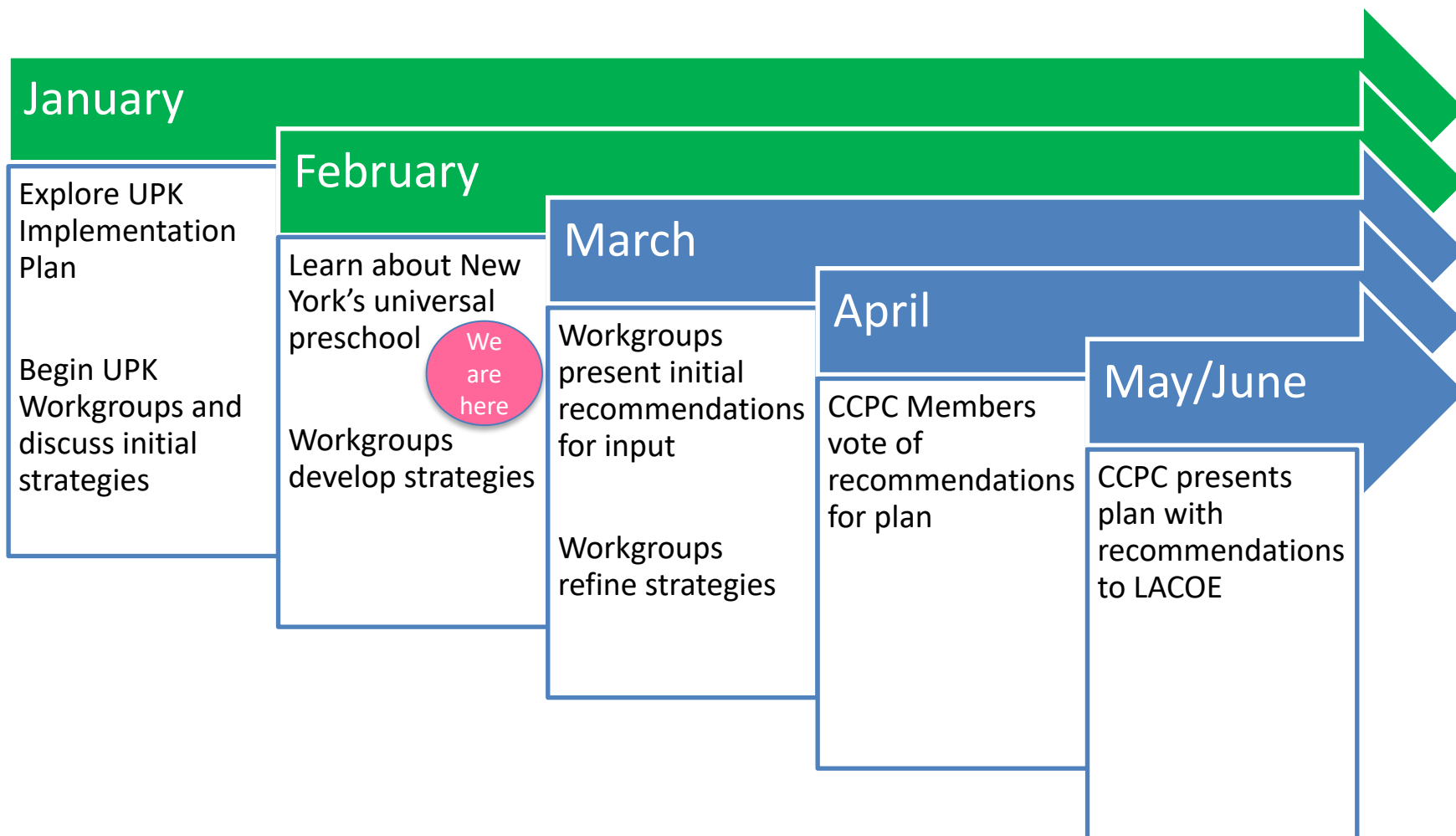
## **FCCHENs**
