## Annual Childhood Immunization Assessment and Reporting Activity

- All California childcare facilities and schools are required by law to assess and electronically report the immunization status of children entering Childcare, Kindergarten, and 7<sup>th</sup> grade on an annual basis.
- Information provides estimates of coverage of vaccinations required to enter childcare facilities, kindergarten, and 7<sup>th</sup> grade.




### **DPH Data to Action Plan for Schools**

- DPH conducted a survey to follow-up with schools that report >10% of their kindergarten cohorts conditionally reported or overdue for required vaccines
- Surveys links were sent via email in April 2023 and follow up calls were made to individual schools
- 201 responses were received for the 2022-23 school year
- 55% public and 45% private schools




## What are the challenges or factors contributing to the high rate of kindergarten students with overdue doses?

### **DPH Data to Action Plan for Schools (continued)**

- Series of summer presentations on assessment results and action plan for staff at public, private, and independent schools
- Training series covering immunization requirements, assessment, reporting, expectations for conditional admission follow-up, navigating medical exemptions
- TA on obtaining access to CAIR (SCRL)
- TA on navigating CAIR-ME to verify medical exemption records
- In-person or virtual site-visits offering TA with review of immunization practices and records (limited schools requesting or appearing to need intensive support)

- Launch of interactive data dashboard with site-level data on immunization coverage and trends (August 2023)







## The School and Childcare Roster Lookup (SCRL)

The California Immunization Registry Medical Exemption web site is a secure site for physicians to issue and manage standardized medical exemptions for children in school or child care. Parents use the same site to request medical exemptions from vaccination for their children. Schools and child care facilities can monitor and get updates for medical exemptions issued for children in



California-licensed MDs and DOs can register to issue and manage medical exemptions in the CAIR Medical Exemption web site. Registration is quick and easy, with a real-time license validation through the California Department of Consumer Affairs.



If your child needs a medical exemption, register now with an email address to request the exemption from your child's doctor. The request process is quick and easy and can be done from your mobile device. The site will walk you through each step of the process.



California schools and licensed child care facilities can access the CAIR Medical Exemption web site once a child attending the school or child care facility has been issued a medical exemption. If your school or child care facility has received a medical exemption, you can request access by emailling medicalexemptions@cdoh.ca.gov.
